


St James Park - Home of the Grecians

Exeter City's St James Park stadium is conveniently located in the heart of the city.

The stadium is going through an extensive redevelopment project throughout the whole of the 2017/18 season, which sees the away end closed. Away fans are now housed towards the end of the IP Office Main Stand, an all seated stand with a capacity of 1600. The stadiums capacity for this season is around 6000.

Visiting by Train


The closest station is Exeter St James station which is conveniently located right outside of the stadium: Well Street, Exeter EX4 6PX.

Visiting by Car

From the M5: Exit westbound at Junction 29 onto the A3015 (Honiton Road). Follow the road onto the B3183 (Heavitree Road) for two miles, going past Royal Devon & Exeter Hospital. Take the fourth exit at the roundabout into Western Way, and at the next roundabout take the second exit onto Old Tiverton Road. St James Park and Stadium Way are located on the left.

From the East: Follow the A303/A30 towards Exeter, passing under the M5 bridge, at Junction 29. Then follow the above instructions from the M5.

From the West: Follow signposts towards Exeter centre. After crossing the River Exe near Exeter St Thomas rail station, join the A3015 (Frog Street). Follow the one-way system and then exit onto the B3212 (Magdalen Street) and follow the road as it veers left towards the roundabout. Take the third exit at the roundabout into Western Way, and at the next roundabout take the second exit onto Old Tiverton Road. St James Park and Stadium Way are located on your left.



Parking:

Please note that there is no on-site parking for supporters at St James Park on matchdays. There is also very limited residential parking available locally.

Visiting by Bus:

The following bus routes run via Old Tiverton Road, adjacent to St James Park:

E (Lancelot Rd − City Centre − Exwick)

F1 (Lancelot Rd – Prince Charles Rd – City Centre – Redhills – Exwick)

F2 (Lancelot Rd – Prince Charles Rd – City Centre – Redhills – Exwick)

The following bus routes stop by the Odeon cinema on Sidwell Street, less than five minutes walk from the stadium:

1 (Exeter - Cullompton - Tiverton)

1B (Exeter - Cullompton - Willand)

G (Hamlin Gardens – City Centre – The Quay)

K (Pinhoe - City Centre - Countess Wear)

P (Pennsylvania – City Centre – High Meadows – Crossmead)


P2 Red (Honiton Road Park & Ride - City Centre)


T (Pinhoe - City Centre - Topsham)

Exeter Bus Station is located around 10 minutes walk from St James Park.

Flying in:

Exeter International Airport is situated in Clyst Honiton, four miles from the city centre. Our principle sponsor Flybe serves 25 destinations directly, including nine destinations within the British Isles.





Ticket Office

The Exeter City ticket office has a welcoming and helpful team to assist with all ticketing related queries, for both home and away supporters.

Club Shop



One of the most important part of any match day! We have a wide range of hot and cold drinks and snacks available at the kiosk for away fans.



Centre Spot Bar

Away fans are welcome in the Centre Spot Bar at the ground located close to reception. The bar offers a friendly atmosphere, with a large range of drinks, and a pool table and dart boards.

Accessibility Information

Parking and Access

Accessible parking is very limited, (supporters are advised to contact club reception for availability). Access is through the accessible gate to the Big Bank Stand via Stadium Way, it is fairly level and ramps are in use within the Stadium.

Places and Positions:

Wheelchair users (designated areas)

3 Away Supporters: Area is elevated within the IP Office Main Stand (Area 4 - Covered).

Dedicated commentary service:

10 headsets available for Home & Away supporters. Supporters wishing to use the service are advised to contact club reception on **01392 411243** to reserve a headset.

Deaf and Hard of Hearing:

Unlimited places. On request, a Portable Induction Loop is available for use in the club shopand reception.

Assistance Dogs:

Assistance dogs are admitted to the ground. The Club's Stadium Manager or Disability Liasion Officer should be contacted in advance for all relevant information.


Wheelchair for Hire:

The club has two wheelchairs available for hire on match days for those supporters who have a need of a wheelchair because of a temporary disablement. Anyone requiring the use of one of these chairs are advised to contact club on: **01392 411243**

Accessible Toilets & Catering:

One adapted toilet in corner of Thatchers' Big Bank Stand near entrance to stadium, the area is stewarded and a Radar key locking system is used. Catering Facilities are available but not dedicated.
